

## YOUR GIFT MAKES HEALING POSSIBLE

Every dollar helps create safety, comfort, and hope for children in our community.



**\$5** Provides a case of water for the children and families we serve.  
**\$10** Supplies snacks and juice boxes to help kids feel at ease during their visit.  
**\$15** Covers the cost of materials for a comforting handmade blanket for one child.  
**\$25** Funds hygiene items for two children's personalized comfort bags.  
**\$52 (just \$1 per week)** - Trains five adults to recognize and prevent child abuse.  
**\$104 (just \$2 per week)** - Provides a mental health assessment for one child or dinner for a therapy group.  
**\$260 (just \$5 per week)** - Ensures transportation for a child to attend seven therapy sessions.  
**\$365 (just \$1 per day)** - Supports forensic interviews for three children, giving them a safe space to share their stories.  
**\$520 (just \$10 per week)** - Delivers specialized training for child abuse investigators, strengthening cases and ensuring justice.  
**\$1,040 (just \$20 per week)** - Funds 10 professional therapy sessions for a child on their healing journey.
