CONTEST GUIDELINES



Strengths in Overcoming
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Eligibility: Open to all artists 18 years of age and younger residing in Cumberland County, Fort Bragg and Pope Field and DoDEA schools.

THEME: ECHOES OF FALL: CELEBRATING RESILIENCY THRU YOUNG EYES. MAKE A PIECE OF ART THAT SHOWS YOU CELEBRATING RESILIENCY THRU YOUNG EYES. THE ARTWORK MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A 25– 200 WORD ESSAY THAT EXPLAINS WHY THE ARTWORK REPRESENTS RESILIENCY THRU YOUNG EYES. *FOR MORE COPIES OF THIS FORM PLEASE GO TO WWW.CACFAYNC.ORG.*

FORMAT AND SIZE: EACH ARTIST MAY SUBMIT ONE WORK OF ART. ARTWORK ACCEPTED : OIL, WATERCOLOR, ACRYLICS, PASTELS, AND MIXED MEDIA. ART MUST BE ON PAPER OR CANVAS PAPER (NOT IN FRAMES), MEASURING ONE OF THESE TWO STANDARD SIZES; LANDSCAPE (11 INCHES BY 14 INCHES) OR PORTRAIT (8.5 INCHES BY 11 INCHES). THE ESSAY CAN BE HAND-WRITTEN OR TYPED AND SHOULD BE PAPER CLIPPED TO THE ART ENTRY.

ENTRY FEE: FREE! THERE IS NO CHARGE TO SUBMIT WORK FOR THIS CONTEST.

AWARDS: \$100 ART SUPPLY SHOPPING SPREE FOR FIRST PLACE AND ART SUPPLY GIFT BASKETS FOR SECOND AND THIRD PLACES WILL BE AWARDED.

JURIED SELECTION PROCESS: REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE ARTS COMMUNITY AND THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER WILL SELECT FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD PLACE WINNERS FROM THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES: KINDERGARTEN - 2ND GRADE, 3RD GRADE - 5TH GRADE, MIDDLE SCHOOL, AND HIGH SCHOOL.

TIMELINE OF COMPETITION: HAND DELIVER WORKS TO THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER (222 ROWAN STREET) BETWEEN OCTOBER 19-23, 2026 - 8:30AM-5:00PM.

WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE ART CONTEST RECEPTION HELD AT THE DOWNTOWN CUMBERLAND COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY ON NOVEMBER 5, 2026, AT 5:00 PM. *(AN EMAIL WILL BE SENT TO THOSE WHO WILL BE RECOGNIZED AT THE EVENT.)*

NO CALLS OR VISITS MAY BE MADE TO THE CENTER TO LEARN ABOUT WINNERS AHEAD OF TIME. ART MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE CAC BETWEEN 9 AM AND 4:30 PM BETWEEN NOV. 30- DEC. 4. ANY ARTWORK NOT PICKED UP BY DECEMBER 4TH WILL BE CONSIDERED ABANDONED BY THE ARTIST AND DISPOSED OF WITHOUT RECOURSE TO THE ARTIST.

RIGHTS AND CONDITIONS: THE ARTIST GRANTS THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER AND ITS PARTNERING AGENCIES PERMISSION TO PHOTOGRAPH/VIDEOTAPE ANY WORKS ACCEPTED FOR THE COMPETITION FOR ARCHIVAL, PUBLICATION AND PUBLICITY PURPOSES. ALL WORKS OF ART, INCLUDING THE FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD PLACE WINNING PIECES, BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE CAC, INCLUDING REPRODUCTION RIGHT. PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION PROCESS CONSTITUTES AN UNDERSTANDING AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN THIS PROSPECTUS.
